**PASSPORT** - A valid passport is required and must be obtained by each passenger at your local passport office or by securing an application from your local post office.

**TRANSPORTATION** - Airfare included in tour is from Los Angeles International Airport (LAX). Travel to and from LA is not included in the tour. An all deluxe motor coach to and from sites, etc. in Israel, Greece, & Turkey is covered. Any taxi or other non-tour travel in Israel is not covered in tour package.

## Details of Our Study Tour

Sept 8 - 19, 2011

*(These details are tentative & subject to change)*

**Day 1** - Depart from LAX for our flight to Tel-Aviv

**Day 2** - Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel-Aviv & begin our pilgrimage with a visit at Caesarea to see the City built by Herod the great & named for his benefactor, Augusta Caesar. The Apostle Paul landed here several times, & from here was sent in chains to Rome for trial. Today, this is a great archaeological park with an impressive Roman Theatre, Hippodrome for horse and chariot races, palaces, Roman bath houses & more. A most important finding that originated from here is the Pontius Pilot pillar. We continue by deluxe motor coach to our hotel on the sea of Galilee in Tiberias for dinner & overnight.

**Day 3** - After a hearty Israeli breakfast, we start our sightseeing with a visit to the Mt. of Beatitudes, the site of the Sermon on the Mount. Then a short ride to Tabgha, site of the miracle of the multiplication of the "loaves & fish." We will then proceed to Capernaum to visit the Synagogue in which our Lord ministered. We will visit Peter's mother-in-law's house & Mensa Christi (John 21) where Jesus had breakfast with Peter & asked, "*Do you love me?*" Then we visit the Kibbutz which shows the original ancient boat; going back to the time of Jesus. Afterwards, we will enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee & head to a restaurant on the dock for a St. Peter's fish lunch. And then, the river Jordan for water baptisms! We will view the Golan-Heights (Bashan Heights). Then back to the hotel for another fabulous dinner & overnight stay on the Sea of Galilee.

**Day 4** - We will travel to the ancient city of Beth She'an - a superbly preserved Canaanite, Roman & Byzantine city along the Jordan Valley, where Saul & his sons bodies were hung on the walls of the city by the Philistines.(1Samuel 31). We will explore Cardo, Deco-manus, Agora, climb up the Tel and view Mt. Gilboa. We continue through the Jordan Valley, view Jericho, the oldest city on earth, & view the Mt. of Temptation (Luke 4) and Elisha's spring. **Up to Jerusalem! Up to Zion!** We'll travel on the old Roman road & view the curves of the

ancient road leading from Galilee to Zion - & see the 'valley of the shadow of Death.' We enter Jerusalem & go to the Mt. of Olives observation point. Standing in the footsteps of Jesus, we will look over the city: to the Golden Gate, the temple Mount, the Dome of the Rock, the old city of Jerusalem, David's city, the Garden tomb, the church of the Holy Sepulcher, and the modern city. (Psalm 122). We have dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

**Day 5** - We start our day at the Israeli Museum with the Model of Jerusalem in the time of Jesus. Then off to the Shrine of the book and see the amazing Dead Sea Scrolls, perhaps the most important archeological finding in history!

**Day 6** - We head up to the Temple Mount, Mt. Moriah, where Abraham brought his son, Isaac, as a sacrifice. Also this is the location where the 1st & 2nd temples were built - today it is where the Dome of the Rock stands. We will see the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus healed the paralytic (John 5), & visit the church of St. Ann - the birthplace of Mary. We continue to the Litostartus, the Fortress of Antonia - the 'judgment place'. On this holy ground we'll retrace the events in the final hours of Jesus' life. After lunch we will visit the Wailing Wall - the western retaining wall of the 2nd temple, walk through the old city bazaar to the Jewish Quarter. We will visit the Garden of Gethsemane (Mark 14) The Rock of Agony, where Jesus wept & sweat blood. To the house of Caiaphas, the upper room, the site of the last supper, and the Garden Tomb - followed by communion. Then we will have some free time to explore Jerusalem & walk the old city walls - followed by a wonderful dinner.

### **Day 7 - Flight to Athens, Greece**

After arrival, we board our bus for the trip to the Parthenon - the most important surviving building of classical Greece. We will visit Mars Hill (the Areopagus - Acts 17:19) where Paul addressed the philosophers of ancient Athens. Free time for walking & shopping at the ancient Greek market. Dinner in Athens.

**Day 8** - After a great breakfast we head to ancient Corinth, a major commercial crossroads in the time of the Apostle Paul and the city where Paul spent over a year in ministry (Acts 18:11). We will see the very road that Paul walked on almost 2000 years ago when he entered the city. We will stand

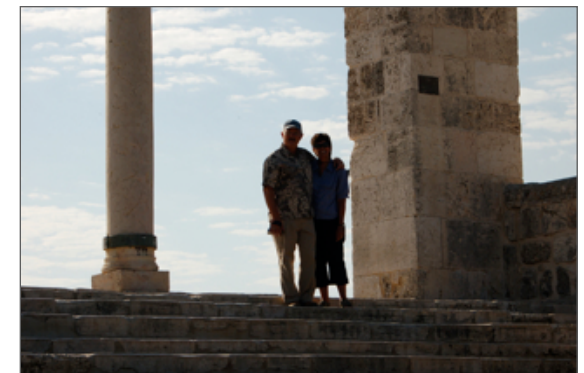
on the Bemah platform where Paul's case was dismissed by Roman proconsul Gallio (Acts 18:12). We will also see the Corinthian canal which connects the Aegean and Adriatic Seas.

**Day 9** - After breakfast we go to the port of Piraeus in Athens, where we will board our cruise ship. We head south for the Aegean island of Mykonos & have time to explore this charming island, and walk along the white narrow streets and have coffee or ice cream. We'll return to the ship for dinner and overnight.

**Day 10** - After breakfast we disembark on the beautiful island of Patmos. It was here that the Apostle John was exiled (Rev.1:9) and wrote the book of Revelation. After returning to the ship, we will sail for Turkey to the ancient city of Ephesus. Paul dedicated over 2 years to ministry to this city. (Acts 19:10). Among the many discoveries that archaeologists have made here in Ephesus is the unearthing of the 25,000 seat theater where the riot happened that the Bible tells us about in Acts 19:29. We then re-board our ship for night cruising to the island of Crete.

**Day 11** - After breakfast, we disembark and visit the beautiful island of Crete. We will have free time to see the harbor and do some exploring. Dinner and overnight on board ship.

**Day 12** - Departure back to the U.S., arriving home with memories that will last a lifetime. After walking in the footsteps of our Lord & in the footsteps of the Apostle Paul - the Bible is now more alive, more familiar, more personal than ever before! Shalom!
